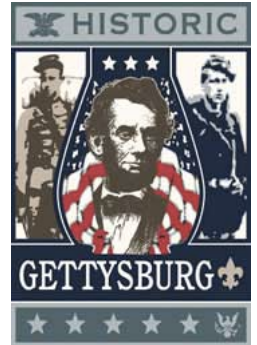


# CUB SCOUT PACK 125 PARTICIPATES in the *Gettysburg Heritage Trail Program*

## Program Overview

The New Birth of Freedom Council, the National Park Service and the Gettysburg National Military Park / Eisenhower National Historic Site are offering Scouting groups the opportunity to participate in the Gettysburg Heritage Trails Program, which includes a stop at the Visitor Center / National Cemetery, two hiking trails through the battlefield at Gettysburg, a walking tour of historic downtown Gettysburg and a tour of the Eisenhower National Historic Site.



## The Five Program Segments...

<b>The Visitor Center / National Cemetery</b>	Tour sections of the Visitor Center / National Cemetery to gain understanding of the Civil War.	Completes requirements for <b>Lincoln Patch</b>
<b>The Billy Yank Trail</b>	A 10-mile hike that is estimated to take 6-hours to complete – Provides a Scout with a Union Soldiers perspective during the Battle of Gettysburg.	Completes requirements for the <b>Billy Yank Patch</b>
<b>The Johnny Reb Trail</b>	A 4-mile hike (may be completed in portions) that is estimated to take 2-3 hours to complete – Provides a Scout with Confederate Soldiers perspective during the Battle of Gettysburg.	Completes requirements for the <b>Johnny Reb Patch</b>
<b>The Eisenhower National Historic Site (NHS)</b>	Visit the home of the President preserved as the Eisenhower NHS. The home and farm reflects the life of the man loved by Americans and respected by the world for his role in World War II.	Completes requirements for the <b>Eisenhower Patch</b>
<b>The Historic Gettysburg Trail</b>	Approx. 3-mile walk, through downtown Gettysburg that is estimated to take 2-3 hours to complete. Provides a perspective of what is was like to live in Gettysburg during the time of the Battle.	Completes requirements for the <b>Historic Gettysburg Trail</b>

Once all Segment requirements have been met, The **“Lincoln Metal”** is awarded.
